A LITTLE

RESPECT

Patrick Stluka and fellow Navy trainers found themselves breaking new ground in the 1970s while stationed in San Diego. Women were new to certain occupations in the military, and so was sexual harassment training.

Some of the old guards did not welcome the change with open arms. “There were people that would say, ‘This isn’t my Navy anymore, so I probably should just retire,’” Stluka said. Still, there were many others who considered the training enlightening and accepted the change.

Stluka, 64, now a veteran in academia, has been a senior adjunct professor in ethics and other organizational studies for nearly 30 years at the University of La Verne. He has been working as National Labor Relations Manager at Toyota Motor Sales the last 17 years.

His roles in higher education and human resources go hand in hand, he says. And one thing he hopes his students and colleagues learn from him is the importance of respect. “Respect for people – that’s what ethics is all about,” Stluka said.

Stluka’s journey began while he was stationed at Subic Bay Naval Base in the Philippines in the 1970s. University of La Verne classes were offered there, so he began pursuing a degree in business administration. He continued night classes, working on a master’s degree in Business Administration. When he came back to the U.S., he focused his studies on industrial relations. He earned both his MBA and a master’s degree in Human Resources from other institutions.

Stluka began working for a manufacturing company in the City of Industry, eventually becoming human resources manager. It was not a position without challenges. The company was forced to make pay cuts

during tough financial times, a decision that affected hundreds of hourly-wage employees. Emotions ran high. Employees ultimately realized the move saved jobs and was the right thing to do.

At Toyota, Stluka says the company’s success lies in its respect for its associates and the dedication to continuous improvement. Other companies reach out to them to learn more about their production methods and quality. Stluka’s day-to-day office anecdotes transfer into the classroom, giving students a real-world perspective on human resources.

Melvin Cook, a reserve officer with Monterey Park Police Department and operations manager for the San Gabriel Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District, says what he learned in a stress management course taught by Stluka has been invaluable in his professional life. He supervises around 20 people on any given shift for Vector Control.

Stluka taught him to manage daily stress by taking tasks off his plate that do not have priority. “It’s one thing that I’ll always remember,” said Cook, who is pursuing a master’s degree at La Verne in leadership and management.

Former students stay in touch with him, seeking guidance on workplace issues and telling him how his instruction has helped. “If they’re able to make some change in their organizations,” he said, “I feel like I’ve done some good.”



Victoria Keyser '03, '11 remembers a key moment in her life that prompted her to consider going back to college to earn her degree.

A self-proclaimed “helicopter parent,” she could not help but linger around the playground after she dropped off her only daughter, Madison, at preschool. “I would hide in the bushes,” she laughed, “to watch her on the playground.”

The covert effort worked until one of her daughter’s playmates caught her. “Teacher, I can see shoes poking out of the bushes!” the preschooler squealed. “I think it’s Maddy’s mommy.”

Keyser laughs and rolls her eyes at the memory. “On the way home, I remember thinking how my daughter was everything in my life and how, one day, she would grow into an adult and not need me so much. What would I do then? At that moment, I knew, I needed to do something for myself.”

Soon after her realization, Keyser enrolled in the University of La Verne’s Campus Accelerated Program for Adults (CAPA), where she graduated with a degree in sociology. Although she earned her bachelor’s degree, the academic milestone was only the beginning.

Since that graduation day, Keyser has pursued and earned both a master’s degree in social work from California State University San Bernardino, as well as a doctorate in Clinical Psychology from La Verne. Founder of Youtherapy Psychology Services, a nonprofit agency committed to providing psychological services for children and adolescents in La Verne, Claremont and Pomona, Keyser says she is living out her life’s dream.

“To offer top-quality services to people who perhaps would not traditionally think of going to therapy or could not afford to go is what I have always wanted to do,” she said. “And I wanted to provide them in the same type of agency environment that more privileged areas have. I knew as a student that my clients would deserve that same experience.”

One of the first people she shared this dream with was her dissertation chair, La Verne Professor of Psychology Dr. Glenn Gamst. In fact, when she was teaching as an adjunct professor at the

University and working part-time at its Counseling Center after she had graduated and passed her licensure exam, it was Dr. Gamst who reminded her of what she should be doing.

BACK TO BASICS

Stephen Fomba '17 did not mind his daily trek to and from school as a child growing up, even if some days it meant walking as many as 20 miles under the blistering-hot sun. Like most living in Africa's Eastern Province of Sierra Leone, commuting by foot was and still is a way of life. But what he did mind was having to make these long trips over the burning, rocky ground completely barefoot.



Sharp stones, thorns and broken glass led to open sores under his feet. He remembers the bleeding and infections that resulted from his regular commute. Like many living in the West African Konjo Village, he picked up ailments and diseases, some he believes could have been prevented had he been able to afford a decent pair of shoes.

These are memories etched in Fomba's mind as he recalls what his life was like some 20 years ago, before fleeing to the U.S. during the Sierra Leone Civil War for a chance at a better life.

Today, Fomba is a husband and father, and works as the program manager for the San Gabriel Valley Consortium on Homelessness, while also pursuing a doctorate in public administration (DPA) at the University of La Verne. He has worked hard to put himself through school so that he can make a difference in the lives of others. However, a piece of him remains in Sierra Leone, a nation that has been in the spotlight recently due to the devastating Ebola virus outbreak.

In October, the World Health Organization and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reported 4,493 Ebola deaths – with more than 2,950 cases and 930 deaths in Sierra Leone alone. Fomba found himself at the center of heartbreak and anxiousness.

"I have lost seven relatives to Ebola during this crisis," Fomba said. "It could have been more had I not called my family and begged them to go to the treatment center."

Fomba said that due to a lack of confidence in the government's role in public health, many in his country do not seek help from treatment centers because they fear they will be poisoned. Thanks to his influence, many of his relatives were spared after seeking early treatment.

Ebola crept into his family after his uncle assisted a fallen motorcyclist. Not knowing the motorcyclist had the virus, Fomba's uncle contracted Ebola and spread it to others in his family.

Until recently, many individuals were not aware that the Ebola virus is spread through blood or bodily fluid exchange with an infected individual.

"We have had a lot more infectious diseases that have been killing sub-Saharan Africans, including Sierra Leoneans, in large numbers every year. I mean, we're talking about malaria, hepatitis, typhoid and, most commonly, cholera," Fomba said. "These are diseases that kill people year-round, so, I asked myself, 'Why are we just expecting these things? Where are these diseases coming from? And what can we do with the very little that we have to actually curb some of these problems?'"

Then it clicked. After recalling his own childhood and the living situation of his family back home, he realized this issue is not simply due to the lack of vaccinations and medications readily available, it is also the lack of basic human needs.

"Take malaria, for example. One easy solution to prevent this disease from spreading is to use mosquito nets. But how many Sierra Leoneans have mosquito nets? Very few. Because people are so poor that buying a mosquito net is not a priority," Fomba said.

Why are we just expecting these things? Where are these diseases coming from? And what can we do with the very little that we have to actually curb some of these problems?





“This is a country where people are living on less than two dollars a day, if they can even get the two dollars. Too often, it’s not about buying a mosquito net, but instead, feeding their children.”

In the case of Ebola, Fomba knows that one necessity of the villagers is shoes. He knows, from his own experience, that if an infected person is walking barefoot, sweating and possibly bleeding from an open wound, others walking that same path can become infected.

In an August 2014 article that went viral on the Internet, Fomba shared his concern and his idea that something as basic as a pair of shoes could help curtail the Ebola outbreak. His article ran in *The Washington Post* and *Time Magazine*, as well as other outlets from around the world, sparking discussion on how access to basic human needs can help curb the outbreak of diseases.

“As a result of this article, I have received hundreds of contacts from people and organizations who want to partner with me,” Fomba said.

The support he is receiving could not have come at a more crucial time, as Fomba works to alleviate the spread

of the Ebola virus by launching his own nonprofit organization, Basics for Humanity. “My goal is not to reinvent the wheel. I don’t want to do shoe drives if other people can do it better than I can. But I can be the center player to facilitate and connect these organizations to where the help is needed most,” Fomba said.

In his second year in La Verne’s DPA program, Fomba’s goals are ambitious and intentional. He plans to operate and grow his nonprofit while working and completing his doctorate, with a target graduation date of spring 2017. After graduation, his goal is to move with his family to Sierra Leone so he can put his degree into practice and, ultimately, influence the local public health operations.

“I think it’s only fair that someone like me go back to Sierra Leone and see how I can apply my La Verne education and actually work as a public administrator. There are a lot more challenges in Sierra Leone, so I believe that I will be able to make the most difference there,” Fomba said.

CAPTURING THE UNDOCUMENTEDS' PURSUIT
OF THE AMERICAN DREAM

A bandana-clad gang member who emerged from the Oaxacan jungle approached Don Bartletti and pulled out a foot-long machete as a nearby train roared to life. Bartletti, a veteran *Los Angeles Times* photographer documenting the immigration of Latin Americans to the United States, had survived countless precarious situations during his career, but that day in 2000, he was alone. "It was my worst nightmare come true," he said.

The shrewd photographer used words to talk his way out of a violent attack. He offered to take the man's picture, which the gang member declined. Eventually, they parted ways – Bartletti on foot and the gang member on the train. They never saw each other again.

Bartletti, winner of the Pulitzer Prize for his portfolio on the *L.A. Times* story "Enrique's Journey" shared such stories at the University of La Verne, which hosted an exhibit of Bartletti's work in the Irene Carlson Gallery of Photography from August to October.

The exhibit, "Uneasy Neighbors: The Causes and Consequences of Undocumented Migration to the

United States," brings Bartletti full circle. He exhibited "Enrique's Journey" photos at La Verne in 2003. The recent shows include additional images, from a lifeless 6-year-old Honduran girl shot through the heart by gang members, to immigrants running across Interstate 5 in San Ysidro, Calif., toward their American Dream. He says the photos update the immigration discussion.

"While pundits take sides on the issue, Bartletti's work approaches immigration from all angles and without bias," said La Verne Photography Department Chair Gary Colby. "What you see in these photographs is the soul of people in need." The exhibit is one of four the department is holding this year in celebration of the gallery's 25th anniversary.

Bartletti says despite dedicating more than 30 years to newspaper photography – much of that time focusing on undocumented immigration – he has no plans to give it up any time soon. And even when he does, the country's immigration debate will live on. "It's the never-ending story," Bartletti said. To learn more about upcoming exhibits, visit sites.laverne.edu/photography.



DOUBLE SWITCHED

Joe Winterburn '14 bucked the norm and heard his name called by the Boston Red Sox in the 40th round of the 2014 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft on June 7 after playing his senior season at the University of La Verne.

For most who dream of playing professional baseball and want a shot at the big leagues, graduating from a competitive NCAA Division I school with a track record of putting players in the pros makes the most sense.

This was not the case for Joe Winterburn, whose name was called by the Boston Red Sox in the 40th round of the 2014 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft this summer, having spent his senior season playing with University of La Verne's baseball team.

The entire draft experience was a roller-coaster ride. Winterburn was following the draft on his computer and got a call from the Red Sox — who had shown him the most interest — in the 20th round and figured he was about to get an offer. He did not.

"I was charting out which interested teams were taking catchers. Each time a catcher would go to one of those teams, it was a little bit more agonizing for me to watch as a dad," said Scott Winterburn, Joe's father and La Verne head baseball coach. "I thought a lot about what I was going to say to him if he didn't get picked."

His father never had to have that conversation. He got the call in the 40th round. The twist was the organization decided to use Winterburn as a pitcher instead of a catcher.

"I'm pretty sure the neighbors at the end of the block could hear me screaming when I learned he was picked," Scott Winterburn said.


Looking back, neither Winterburn had any idea Joe would end up at La Verne for his senior season. He initially chose UC Santa Barbara after being recruited by a virtual Who's Who of Southern California baseball powerhouse. But coaching staff changes threw him off rhythm and his father offered an opportunity to transfer to La Verne. The younger Winterburn jumped at the chance.

La Verne has a long-established tradition of fielding quality baseball teams with outstanding players. The Leopards have twice won national championships — 1972 and 1995 — and have sent many players into the professional ranks.

Winterburn excelled both on the diamond and off. Not only was he drafted by one of the most prestigious organizations in all of professional sports, he did it while carrying an 18-unit course load for his business major, maintaining a 3.6 grade-point average.

"Joe's accomplishments are a validation that La Verne is a place where your dreams can come true if you work hard enough," Scott Winterburn said. "It sends a message that everyone can succeed at La Verne if they value the experience."

CHARLENE MARIE KING '87 rode buses all over Los Angeles as a child. Reading as she traveled, she lost herself in the adventures of Nancy Drew and the Hardy Boys. She sought no destination, only an escape from the nightmares of home.

Her family struggled with poverty, making it difficult to stay in one place for long. She could be uprooted and find herself in a new elementary school at any time. Worst of all, her home was a place of abuse and fear.

The roaring engine and meandering routes of the bus gave her sanctuary in a world where she had trouble finding any. "It was safe," she said. "Kids weren't getting snatched back then like they are now."







he University of La Verne graduate has since escaped those adversities, rebuilding her fractured life bit by bit. She now dedicates her time to rebuilding the lives of others through her disaster-relief organization, The Not Forgotten Project.

Despite having a bachelor's degree in psychology that

could land her a full-time paying job, she sacrifices that kind of stability and lives with her sister's family so she can leave on a moment's notice. There have been many such occasions since she started the organization in 2008.

Of the 25 trips she has taken to help communities torn by natural and unnatural disasters, King has been to the Gulf Coast 19 times for hurricane relief. She and her team members sifted through ashes in Colorado Springs, Colo., in 2012 to help families reclaim items thought lost during that summer's devastating fires. She helped clean up wreckage in the wake of the 2011 Joplin, Mo., tornado. She flew to Galena, Alaska, in September to help a community of 500 residents whose homes were severely damaged or destroyed by flooding, caused by a broken icecap that blocked the mouth of the Yukon River.

She says this is the job God wants her to do. But sticking with it has not been easy, especially when she sees growing piles of bills. "I think this is probably it for the long haul," King said. "I tried to quit last year. I was sitting in the library, crying to God about needing a job and having options."

Within minutes, she began receiving text messages from her colleagues about a tornado in Moore, Okla. Donations from friends and churches followed, paving the way for a relief trip.

Fellow La Verne alumna, Helen Lewis '86, describes King as joyful despite her traumatic past - choosing to ease the burdens of others rather than carry around her own baggage. King stayed with Lewis, a Pennsylvania resident, twice in 2013 for Hurricane Sandy relief.

"There are people that God has selected as angels among us, like God's warriors or soldiers," Lewis said. "She is one of them."

School was the place I went to be away from home, it was my refuge. It was where I went to not think about the things going on in my head.

EARLY BURDENS

King's family relocated from Riverside to Compton when King was 5-years-old to be closer to her aunt and some cousins. Her parents often could not make the rent, and her father was once shot in the chest by an apartment complex manager. He nearly died.

Poverty forced them to move frequently. King went to six different elementary schools. "Every time we changed schools, it was really hard for me," she said.

Meanwhile, King harbored a dark family secret: two family members had been molesting her. The abuse began when she was 3-years-old and continued through her early teenage years.

Neither relative faced conviction. Police arrested one after allegations surfaced, but released him soon after.

Despite the family's financial hardships, King's mother had no problem giving someone a place to sleep in her apartment if the person had nowhere to go.

"We didn't have a lot, but knowing someone who had less, we'd give them what we had," King said. That influence rubbed off on King and her siblings.

The family eventually found stability when King was in junior high school. She joined the girls softball team at Compton High School. She flourished academically.

"School was the place I went to be away from home," King said. "It was my refuge. It was where I went to not think about the things going on in my head."

During a "college night" event in her junior year, the University of La Verne came to visit. The friendliness of staff, the small size of the school, and the distance from Compton appealed to her. She chose to pursue a psychology degree at La Verne and received a full scholarship.

DEMONS RESURFACE

King described La Verne as a place where she reinvented herself. “It was the first time I felt like I belonged,” she said. She settled into Stu-Han Residence Hall with three roommates, diving into classes and college life.

But she had not properly dealt with her childhood traumas. King had no interest in telling classmates about her past, let alone a counselor. When the demons came calling, she turned to alcohol. “It took that to beat down those ghosts, those demons that were attacking me,” she said.

In order to regain control of her life, King sought counseling, but had trouble embracing it. However, she soldiered on, graduating from La Verne in 1987.

King finally got a taste of what she read in the Nancy Drew novels during one of her first jobs out of college. She worked for a private investigator, and also took a position as an engineering assistant for a downtown Los Angeles construction company.



NOT FORGOTTEN

When she was in her mid-20s, King went back to counseling, this time, for the purpose of healing.

She started a job as a counselor at David and Margaret Youth & Family Service in La Verne in 1992. King also worked as a YWCA youth counselor for junior high school girls. At the Boys & Girls Club in Pomona, she led the “Sister-Two-Sister” mentor and volunteer program.

The seed for disaster relief was planted in 2006 when she began working with Habitat for Humanity along the Gulf Coast. While many relief workers flocked to Louisiana, King went to Mississippi a year after Hurricane Katrina hit. She said the devastation there was just as bad, if not worse. The storm swept away buildings, homes and left other areas submerged.

Damage was not limited to structures. King heard about people wanting to get back to work, but could not because of their destroyed homes. She heard about straight-A students slipping to Cs and Ds from stress.

A woman she overheard in an airport described living with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder, an affliction also plaguing her children. She worried that people had forgotten about her community.

King realized there was a void that needed to be filled. Someone needed to continue helping these communities after first responders left. The Not Forgotten Project was born.

Her drive to start the organization also came from Pat Smith, a member of Habitat for Humanity’s international board of directors. His gift for rounding up volunteers from multiple states impressed King. But she only got to meet him once. He died in a plane crash in 2006 while heading to the Gulf Coast.

Vilonia, Ark., is one of the most recent towns King helped. The small suburb of Little Rock lost many homes and businesses to an April tornado that killed 15 people. For resident Karla Arendall, it was the second time she lost her home to a twister in three years. Not Forgotten helped her put the pieces of her life back together.

“They came over and began putting up walls on my slab,” she said. “If it wasn’t for them, I probably wouldn’t have gotten it started so soon. They did a great job and did it quickly, too.”

The strength King gains from helping others keeps her going. “It all comes back to loving people,” she said.

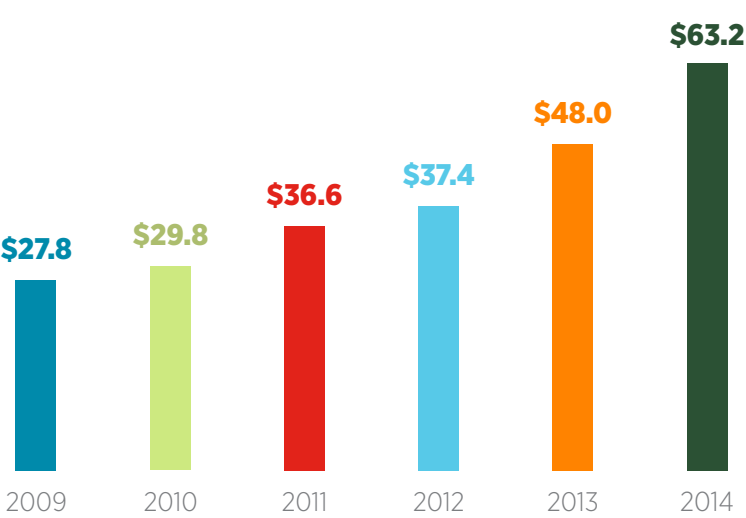


TOTAL ENROLLMENT



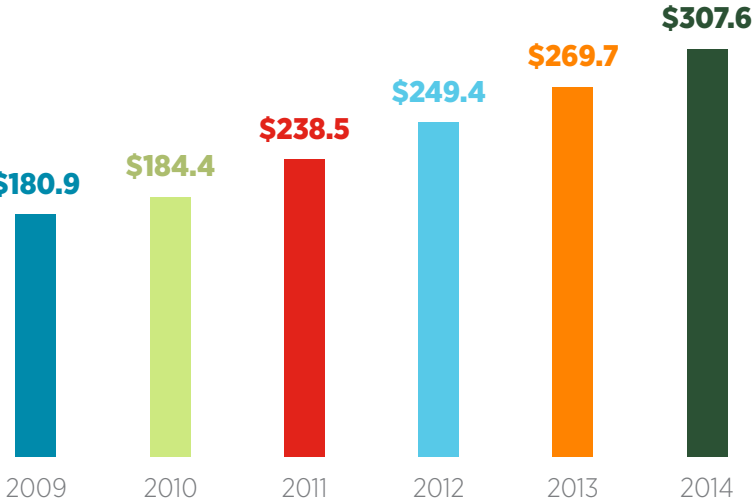

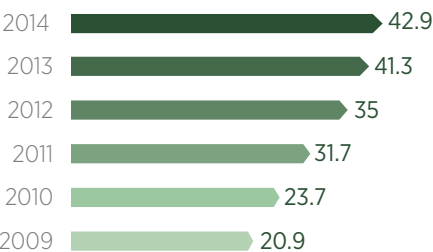
